Contrary to what many would expect, the Rotary Club of Pasig's 56th President Bernardo Cheng Dy is not Binondo-born but is, in fact, an original "Tondo" boy. Bernard or Dody, as his friends call him, was born at Mary Johnston Hospital in Tondo, Manila. He grew up in a large family - the fifth among seven siblings. His early education was Jesuit-guided at Xavier School in San Juan. He earned his bachelor's degree in Business Administration from the University of the Philippines-Diliman [in 19—] and his master's degree from the Asian Institute of Management, where he was one of the students in the pioneer class of the Master in Entrepreneurship (ME) program.

Dody was a natural leader at university. He was elected to the student council of the UP College of Business Administration and served as president of the Junior Marketing Association (JMA), the premier marketing organization in the university. Under his leadership, JMA's membership grew to more than 250 members - a first in the organization's history.

He has brought his knowledge and skills to bear in the management of several companies. His business ventures are focused on protecting lives, assets, and the environment. In 2004, he started his own company, to continue on the legacy in the safety business started by his father 61-years ago. Panpisco Technologies of which Dody is the President and CEO is now one of the industry leaders in the field of safety, tactical defense, and security.

Dody is committed to creating positive change in the world, and he is guided in this mission by his faith. He is actively involved in the Catholic community, whether as a member of formal organizations like the Brotherhood of Christian Businessmen and Professionals (BCBP) or more intimate ones like the village church choir, where he has been singing for more than a decade. He is part of the Xavier School Batch 83 Foundation and





is also an honorary member of the Philippine Military Academy “Maharlika” Class of 1984.

For all his accomplishments, Dody has remained humble, level-headed, and unpretentious. What he considers as his greatest achievement is his family. He is married to Teresa Fe Fernandez, with whom he has four loving children – Keanu, Kafé, Kathy and Kristen. He enjoys cycling and golfing in his leisure time, but nothing gives him more pleasure than cooking for his wife and kids. His melts in your mouth medium rare roast beef and luscious paella are the standouts from among his culinary creations, all of which his children say are better than any restaurant dish.

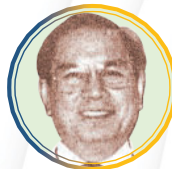

THE HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF PASIG

The Beginnings

In 1970, a group of Rotarians from the Rotary Club of Mandaluyong organized a new club for the municipalities of Pasig and Pateros, then within the Mandaluyong club's jurisdiction. They included Jess Solomon, Emil Ozaeta, Kishu Sehwan, Ito Carlos, and Ernie Paje, together with then Extension Officer of RI District 380, Mon Hechanova of the Rotary Club of Quezon City. A new group began to take shape from a series of preliminary meetings at Madrid Restaurant along EDSA with prospective recruits. By November 1970, this group was sufficiently organized to attain a "provisional club" status, meeting at noon every Tuesday at the Madrid Restaurant. A charter list with 29 names was sent to Rotary International, and on January 18, 1971, a charter formally recognizing the new club was signed by then RI President William E. Walk. It became Club No. 16913 of Rotary International. Thus, the Rotary Club of Pasig born.

The club tried different places and times for weekly meetings in its early years. Aside from Madrid Restaurant, there was a hall in the provincial capitol, the Light House at Meralco, the Manila Chronicle (Benpres) Building cafeteria, the Marco Polo Restaurant on Shaw Blvd, and for many years, the Green Valley Country Club. In 1985, it moved its meeting to the Valle Verde Country Club, where it has continued to meet every Thursday at noon for the past thirty-seven years.



The Line of Presidents

Fifty five illustrious gentlemen have led the club as president, Jose V. Angeles, Teodoro M. Yabut, Miguel V. Ampil, Julio B. Francia Jr., Ernesto E. Lichauco, Justo E. Manalo, Katipunan M. delos Reyes, Virgilio O. Basilip, Roberto M. Paterno, Edilberto C. Gamboa, Rizalino C. Concepcion, Augusto S. Sanchez, Tomas V. Portillo, Benjamin P. de Guzman, Anastacio A. de los Reyes, Rodolfo V. Cruz, Ignacio S. Jose Jr., Peter M. Javier, Achilles G. Bartolome, Juan Y. Fuentes Jr., Pedro M. Sy-Quia Jr., Alberto S. Tayengco, Alberto M. Albano, Romeo B. Manuel, Valentin T. Chua, Alfonso L. Po, Lorenzo R. Regino III, Delfin M. Viola III, Victor A. Aquino, Jose F. Mabanta, Renato R. Ermita, Antonio A. Of the original 29 charter members, only 2 are still members of the club, namely Peping Mabanta and Arjan Ramnani as Esto Lichauco passed away in during the last Rotary Year. Today with 92 members, it is still one of the largest and strongest clubs in District 3800.

Unsteady First Steps

The first years saw the club flounder unsteadily in fledgling infancy, trimming down to the dedicated core of members and groping uncertainly for meaningful direction. The dogged patience and persistent enthusiasm of the charter officers led by Charter President Totoy Angeles, as well as the second set that took over in July 1971 led by Teddy Yabut and the third led by Mike Ampil in 1972, saw the club through these growing pains. Some old-timers remember walking into meetings with less than ten in attendance. Under its second administration, however, the club felt sufficiently organized to stage a fund-raising show Promises, Promises, at the Cultural Center of the Philippines.

As new recruits took the place of the charter members who had lost interest, the club gradually grew in strength and number. Under the third set of officers (1972-1973), the club held a successful Youth Manpower Development and Training seminar and started performing some services for the Rizal High School.

Service to the Community

During its first years, the club made tentative efforts to tackle the drug abuse problem. This was soon given up with the declaration of Martial Law in September 1972 as capital punishment threatened the more serious drug offenders.

The first significant lasting monument to these community service efforts was the setting up of free pre-schools for disadvantaged children, the first during Julito Francia (1973-74) at Barrio Rosario and the second at Barrio Pinagbuhatan under the presidency of Esto Lichauco (1974-75).

In November 1975, the Rotary Anns, or wives of the Pasig Rotarians, organized a large and highly successful bazaar to raise funds for the improvement of the pre-schools. In 1977, these schools were sufficiently organized and stable, so the club decided to turn them over for continued operation to the newly formed Association of the Rotary Anns of Pasig (ARAP). RC Pasig and ARAP supported a Kindergarten at Bgy. Santa Cruz, which included a feeding program. The Anns also launched its Ampon Puso Project for rheumatic heart patients, which continues to this day with a clinic and consultation every 3rd Tuesday of each month at the Medical City.



At Rizal High

Scholarships are prominent among the club's continuing contributions to the community, especially at the Rizal High School. The number of scholars supported by the club during any year has varied. In the mid-1980s, the whole scholarship program was rationalized, systematized, and intensified, especially its selection and monitoring aspects. To make the scholarships more meaningful, the grants were made to cover not only school expenses but also included a modest monthly stipend for the student's other necessary expenses. These grants were made to maintain awardees throughout four years of High School, provided they kept specific performance requirements. Advice and counsel are also given by designated Rotarians. At present, the club supports about 70 scholars at all levels every year.

Occasionally, the club has given more assistance to young people in formal vocational training programs, so some scholarships were established at the Meralco Foundation Institute and other venues for the technical and technician programs. The club also supported a few college students at the Philippine School for Business Administration.

Rizal High School and its youth have provided the arena for many of the club's services. A major infrastructure project improved the water supply system of the school in 1980, benefiting its 16,000 students. In 2009, the club once again began a massive project to improve the school's water and toilet system with the help of the United Laboratory's Bayanihan Foundation. More recently, the club has provided washing and drinking stations in the school.

Rotarians visit the senior or junior class and give career guidance lectures. The club has also regularly donated equipment and books as teaching aids for the vocational program and occasional requirements like garbage receptacles. In 1996, the club completed the construction of a two-classroom building for the Rizal High School Annex at Arkong Bato, Barangay Kapitolyo. In 2008, the club, in partnership with U.S.A.- based National Relief Charities, donated more than thirteen thousand books to the school and followed this up with bookshelves to house them in better conditions. Another shipping container arrived at the end of 2010.



There are also projects to help Rizal High's teachers, such as free vaccination for cervical center and seminars on savings and personal financial management to help them improve their quality of life.

Other Community Service Projects

In response to the call of the first Filipino RI President Matt Caparas, the club organized two Rotary Village Corps groups, among whom the club carried out several livelihood projects. The club got involved with the barangay school in connection with its work with the RVC at Ilugin in Barangay Pinagbuhatan. In 1991, the club built a concrete two-room schoolhouse providing expanded classroom facilities for an additional two hundred schoolchildren. The structure doubled as a community center for residents of the community. In 1993, the club completed major construction project at the school, adding a second story to a completely renovated main building. Next came a two-storey building for a permanent medical and dental clinic. This clinic was operated regularly, making basic medical and dental treatment and health education available to the neighborhood. The original building was torn down due to termite infestation and was completely rebuilt with two floors and 4 classrooms. The students of the Ilugin Elementary School were also recipients of various feeding programs of the club. The city government recently tore down these buildings to replace them with a new complex, providing the club a space for a medical-dental clinic. In 2010, the club agreed with the Medical City Hospital to provide pediatric medical care in this community center in Ilugin. The Ilugin Community Center has expanded its services so that it is now a busy health-focused community center.

Community daycare centers have also been set up in various depressed areas of Pasig, which have not lasted. The club has also been active in emergency relief work. Fires and floods have occasionally hit parts of Pasig, and the club has responded by distributing relief goods such as the big fire at Kapasigan in 1978 and Typhoon Ondoy in 2009. There have been other special projects such as providing sewing machines for a parish educational center, tree planting, loan programs for small businesses, vocational training



programs, job placement programs, vocational service award programs especially for local civil servants, and many more.

Disaster relief has occupied the club many times, especially when parts of Pasig and neighboring towns suffer from floods and after major disasters like the Mt. Pinatubo eruption, the Northern Luzon earthquake, and the recent devastation of Eastern Visayas by Typhoon Yolanda.

Medical missions with consultation, complimentary medicine, vaccinations, and dental and circumcision services are undertaken annually.

In the Rotary year 1998-99, the club, through the work of Rtn. Flor de Pano started what had the potential to become a significant national service institution, a blood bank and data bank for RH Negative and other rare blood types, in cooperation with the National Red Cross and the Department of Health.

To support its service activities on a more stable basis the club set up the Pasig Rotary Club Trust Fund in 1979, with an initial fund of ₱122,000 drawn from earlier fundraising activities of the club and of the Anns. In 2008, the club incorporated The Rotary Club of Pasig Foundation at an initial ₱1 Million, which serves as the vehicle for funding the club's community service work, like the Pasig Rotary-Gawad Kalinga village had achieved scope and dimensions, making a full-blown foundation advisable.

Reaching Out

In spreading the ideals of Rotary, the club has organized four other Rotary clubs within Pasig, that of Pasig South chartered in May 1982, that of Midtown Pasig in May 1985, that of Pasig East in June 1988, and that of Valle Verde in June 1991. The second has since died out, but the other three continue. It recently sponsored the creation of another club in Pasig, the Rotary Club of Pasig Premier, in 2018 and a club in Valenzuela, the Rotary Club of Valenzuela Sunrise, in 2020.

The Rotary Club of Pasig's involvement beyond the club to district affairs has not been very intensive or extensive. But the club has done its part. It has produced two district governors, Dr. Miguel V. Ampil, who served in 1983-84, and Rafael M. Garcia III, who served in 2011-2012. Several past presidents have been active as district officers and in district activities assisting the governors over the years. The club has hosted District Assemblies, District Conferences, and other district events. In the 1980 District Conference, the club put together and published a monumental compilation of Rotary Readings, a handy compendium for all Rotarians. The first basic syllabus on which District 3800's Rotary Academy was developed was written by a Pasig Rotarian HOF/PP Bobby Paterno. The Club is also active in the District 3800 Golf Federation, and the spectacular tournaments sponsored by RC Pasig are much anticipated by the golfers in the District. For the first time, the Club hosted the Oktoberfest in 2023.

Beyond the district, the club has sister-club relations with other Philippine Rotary clubs, and among them are RC Balayan and Downtown Batangas City, both in Batangas, RC Manila Remedios Circle, RC Makati Gems, Mutya ng Pasig, RC Legaspi North, Albay and soon RC Baguio South.

International Service

In the area of International Service, the club has established many so-called sister club relationships. One of the earliest was the Rotary Club of Marugame City, Japan, in 1976. Several others followed. There is a thriving relationship with the Rotary Club of Hong Kong Sunrise, which donated counterpart funds for the club to carry on feeding programs for its pre-school children. The two clubs have had exchange visits over the years. The club also has sister club agreements with the Rotary Club of Ansan Ease (Seoul, Korea), the Rotary Club of Honolulu Sunset, and the Rotary Club of San Diego paradise Valley in California, USA, with whom the club has jointly conducted three medical & dental mission at the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Pasig. Matching grants to assist club projects have been successfully arranged, particularly for the Pasig Rotary GK Village.



In its earlier years the club hosted high school students from the USA and Brazil under RI's Rotary Exchange Program and also sent some, including children of Pasig Rotarians, to the USA and Canada. They all had a year's schooling and stayed with several Rotarian families. Starting with Donna Carr from Canada, in 1976-77, there were Len Cook, USA, and Alex Rizzo, Brazil, in 1980-81. Cathleen Golba from the USA in 1984-85. Tasha Randall and Wendy Wentworth from the USA in 1985-86. Shannon Tocchini, Joseph Kinson, and Matthew Baker in 1986-87. Laura Nunn, USA, in 1989-90, and Benjamin Carlson, USA, in 1992-93. Tasha Randall had to cut her trip short due to the February 1986 EDSA Revolution. Still, Wendy Wentworth chose to experience the unforgettable tension and euphoria of EDSA by insisting on participating side by side with her Rotarian guardians and their children. In exchange, we have sent some of our member's children under the Rotex program to the USA and Canda, one of whom eventually became a member and President of the Club, PP John Javier. Pasig Rotarians have also participated in the Group Study Exchange Program, hosting several teams here, sponsoring at least one member of a team that went abroad, the GSE Team to Michigan and Wisconsin in 1987 and the GSE Team to London in 1995.

50 Years and Beyond

The Club continues to make a difference in Pasig with its many community service projects after five decades.

One of the significant continuing projects is the Ilugin Community Center at the school complex. In cooperation with The Medical City the Ateneo School Medicine and Public Health, Barangay Pinagbuhatan, Philippine Dental Association, the Club operates what for some time was mainly a pediatric clinic with regular feeding programs and other children health welfare programs. Regular gynecological, mammographic, dental, and other services have recently been added. It is now a busy and valuable community center, recently accredited by the Department of Health.

Another continuing community service projects is the Pasig Rotary GK Village located in Sitio Caliwag in Barangay Pinagbuhatan. In collaboration

with Gawad Kalinga, about 150 housing units were programmed for construction in donated lands. Eighty-eight units have been completed. While the club provided the housing units, Gawad Kalinga was to provide educations, values, formation, livelihood, and self-governance promotion. In addition, the Club mobilized assistance from the city government, private corporations, and sister clubs. The residents have benefited from the medical & dental missions, feeding programs, and disaster assistance conducted by the Club. The annual gift-giving at Christmas has brought cheers to the residents.

The Club also embarked on another projects, the Water Hyacinth Livelihood Project at Barangay Pinagbuhatan. A water hyacinth harvester was acquitted through a Global grant which mechanized the gathering of the water hyacinth that clogged the waterways. These water hyacinths are then dried, processed, and weaved into various products such as bags, baskets, and other handicrafts. A Rotary Community Corps was organized at the barangay to undertake this project. Another worthwhile project is the Reintegration Project which aims to rehabilitate former drug users and integrate them into society via a training program followed by employment.

In 2016, a scholarship program was set up for college students at the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Pasig (PLP), and a Rotaract Club was organized with the scholars as its core group.

In 2017, in partnership with the Luxid Foundation, Inc., the Club organized the Luxid Rotary Micro-Finance and Cooperative. The Cooperative aims to provide means through which member's financial needs might be addressed without having to resort to loan sharks. Investment opportunities, as well as financial literacy seminars, are also made available to members. The Cooperative currently has more than 200 associate members.

In 2018, Rafael M Garcia III assumed the position of Rotary International Director for RYs 2018-2020, the first time a Pasig Rotarian became a member of the top governing body of Rotary.



That same year, the Club installed a Human Milk Bank at the Rizal Medical Center through a Global Grant. This project addresses the situation where mothers cannot supply breast milk to their children for various reasons.

Another recent project was the Mammogram Screening at Brgy. Pinagbuhatan, in partnership with Breast Cancer Imperative, Inc., the Cervical Screening Program held at the PLP and the Pasig City Jail Female Dormitory in cooperation with the Rizal Medical Center; the Cleft Palate Surgical Mission at the Rizal Medical Center, a joint project with the Rotary Club of Makati Gems and the Alliance for Smiles, and the OB/GYN and Breast Screening at the Ilugin Elementary School conducted by Medical City's Kalusugan ng Kababaihang Pangkabayanan, Inc. (KnKPInc), The Club also turned over a new portable ultrasound machine purchased under a Global Grant to KnKPInc.

The Pandemics Years

The Pandemic did prevent the Club from continuing with its service projects. Internet access for online classes were provided to the scholars at Rizal High and PLP through wifi devices with a monthly internet load. For the printing of learning modules, the Club donated 620 reams of paper to the Ilugin Elementary School, 80 bags coloring books, crayons, hygiene kits, and small toys were distributed to Special Education (SPED) students at Nagpayong Elementary School under the SPED Eskuela Zone 6 project, Flu vaccinations have been conducted at the Ilugin Medical Center. In addition, the Luxid Rotary Micro-Finance and Credit Cooperative continued its recruitment and orientation programs for prospective members.

At the onset of the Pandemic, the Club raised funds to support a Feeding Program for the 50 front liners at Rizal Medical Center, providing packed meals for lunch and dinner for 103 days and another 24 days for dinner.



Post pandemic to the present - Life changing, Imaginative and Hope Creating Years.

In 2021, the Rotary Club of Pasig established the Pagpupugay sa Kabayanihan ng Pasig Pulis (Ignacio Gimenez Awards) to recognize and reward Pasig City police officers who, in the performance of their duties and the conduct of their personal lives, have demonstrated the values of service, integrity, courage, and respect for the law. The Awards is now on its 3rd year, and 19 individual police officers were recognized for their dedicated service last May 2024.

The Scholarship programs at both Rizal High and PLP were further strengthened. The Club now maintains 70 high school scholars at RHS and 30 college scholars at PLP. Considering the cost of inflation, the Club has increased its stipend for its scholars.

Hope Creating Rotary Year 2023-2024, under President Adolf Aran, may be described as the post pandemic era filled with fun, with eccentricities and with hope.

The fun happened during the birthday celebrations of PP Totoy Bartolome (97 years old), PP/CM Peping Mabanta (95 years old, in Pililla, Rizal) and PP Nerio Laino (88 years old, in Malvar, Batangas). Aside from the annual Christmas Party and the Anniversary party, two Zone wide club meetings (attended by Mayor Vico Sotto and Chief Justice Hilario Davide) led to fellowship activities, among club members and among zone 6 members.

The fun was shared with the District when for the first time, the Club hosted the District' 3800's Oktoberfest. With overflowing beer for the more than 1,200 Rotarians and guests who filled the Metrowalk Tent to the brim, all dancing and singing to the tunes of Joey G, the event was definitely one for the books. As Gov Pope Solis himself said, "I was dumbstruck by the large turnout and also by the euphoria of the crowd!"



The eccentricities reared its head weekly during club meetings, with guest speakers ranging from Mayor Benjamin Magalong to Heidi Mendoza, from Paco Magsaysay to Major General Fabian Pedregosa. The Q&A filled the meeting room with wit, laughter and wisdom.

The hope was created with partners from the community, such as The Medical City, Rizal Medical Center, the surgeons of Dr Henry Claravall and the generous donors coming from the club members. Patients treated, students worked their way to graduation ceremonies, and community residents given blessings during Christmas gatherings. Hope for our younger generation was spread as the Club expanded the Alapabasa Reading Program which aims to better equip our public school teachers to help struggling readers and address the literacy problem. Through a district grant, 28 Kindergarten teachers from 7 public schools were trained so they can better teach 1,400 K1 students this coming schoolyear.

Seven new members were inducted, and 3 members were honored during their memorial service - PP Mike Sehwan, CM/PP Esto Lichauco and Rotarian Demy Magpantay.

In the Hope Creating Rotary Year, it was evident that the Rotary Club of Pasig truly embodied the spirit of resilience, dedication, and community. Under President Adolf Aran's leadership, we have celebrated milestones, supported those in need, and fostered hope through our diverse initiatives and unwavering commitment to service.

After a year of spreading Hope, President Adolf Aran shall pass the mantle to President Bernard Dy under whose brand of leadership, the Club hopes to spread Magic and touch more lives this Rotary Year.



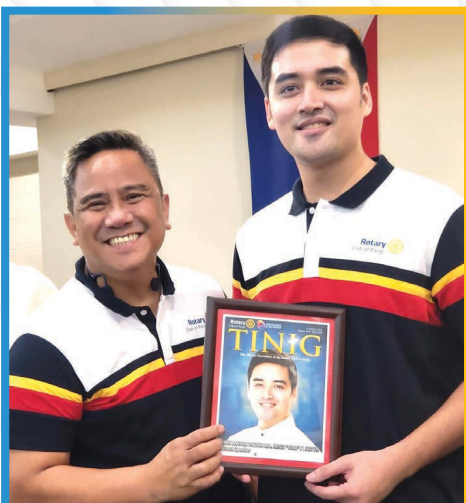
