

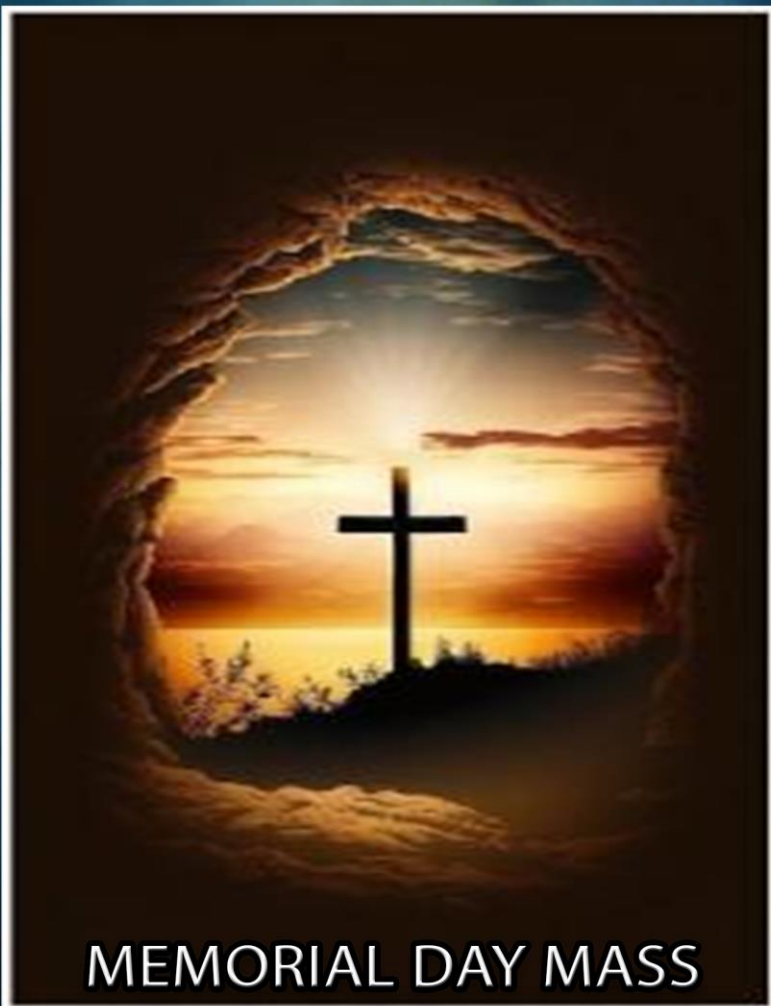

### **Rotary commits funds to polio outbreak response in Gaza**

The recent detection of variant poliovirus type-2 isolates in environmental samples and the confirmation of a 10-month-old child who has contracted polio in Gaza is a stark reminder that as long as polio exists anywhere, it is a threat everywhere.

The ongoing crisis in Gaza has contributed to reduced routine immunization rates and an increased risk of vaccine-preventable diseases, including polio. The crisis also poses a significant challenge to fully implementing disease surveillance and vaccination campaigns.

The World Health Organization (WHO) considers there to be a high risk for the spread of this polio strain within Gaza and internationally, particularly given the current situation's impact on public health services.

A humanitarian pause allowed a two-round polio vaccination campaign to begin in Gaza. The first round was successfully implemented from 1-12 September 2024 and vaccinated 559,161 children, or an estimated 95% of eligible children at the governorate level, according to independently conducted post-campaign monitoring.

The second round of the emergency polio vaccination campaign in Gaza began on 14 October. The campaign started in Central

Gaza, vaccinating children under ten years old with nOPV2, where children aged between 2-9 years old were also offered Vitamin A.

Rotary committed US\$500,000 to bolster the initiative, channeling these funds through a dedicated Polio Outbreak Response Fund. This contribution represents Rotary's sustained support to the WHO in combating polio globally.

Rotary will continue to work with its partners in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative and other agencies as vaccination efforts unfold.

Financial contributions to the PolioPlus fund will help Rotary and its Global Polio Eradication Initiative partners achieve a world in which no child is paralyzed by polio again.

## **The Health Benefits of a Glass of Beer**

Beer is the most popular alcoholic beverage in the world and it's the third most popular beverage overall, after water and tea. In recent years, it received somewhat of a bad reputation for being fattening and high in calories but there are actually various health benefits to be gained when drinking beer in moderation.

### **It Reduces the Risk of Heart Disease**

When consumed in moderation, beer thins the blood, making it less likely to clot and it helps reduce the risk of heart disease and increases the amount of good cholesterol in the blood.

### **It's Good for Kidney Health**

Drinking too much is harmful to your kidneys but moderate consumption of beer has been shown to reduce the likelihood of developing kidney stones.

### **It's Genuinely Nutritious!**

A 12 oz. beer has up to a gram of fiber in it as well as plenty of B vitamins such as B6, B12, niacin and riboflavin. It is also rich in silicon which is a nutrient that helps with strengthening bones.

### **It Reduces the Risk of Diabetes**

In a Harvard University study, participants who drank two beers a day were shown to have a 25% lower risk of contracting Type II diabetes than those who did not.

### **It May Reduce the Risk of Cancer**

A Portuguese study found that marinating meat in beer eliminated almost 70% of all its carcinogens as beer contains plenty of antioxidants which help your body cleanse itself of toxins,

### **It Keeps Your Muscles Strong Into Old Age**

A study at Tokushima University in Japan found that the prenylated flavonoid contained in hops called 8-prenylnaringenin inhibited muscle atrophy in laboratory mice. When fed with the flavonoid, they were found to retain more muscle mass than those fed with a normal diet.

### **It Improve Brain Health**

Having a couple of beer each day contributes towards staving off Alzheimer's Disease and dementia as well as lowering the risk of having a stroke. Those who drank one beer a day exhibited better mental function than those that didn't. Their risk of mental decline was also found to be reduced by 20%.

### **It Can Help Get Rid of Pesky Dandruff**

The high yeast and vitamin B levels found in beer make it one of the best natural treatments for dandruff. Try pouring a bottle of beer over your head two to three times a week and watch it disappear. It will also make your hair soft and shiny.

### **It Can Help Stress At Bay**

Stick within the 12 oz. daily recommended limit for women and the 24 oz. daily recommended daily for men - it will help keep stress levels down and reduce anxiety you might be feeling.

### **It Has Antimicrobial Properties**

The hops used to make beer are known to be antimicrobial, meaning that it can kill microorganisms that could cause you harm
