PCol. Mangaldan also holds a BA in Political Science and History from the Divine Word College and MBA from the Adventist University of the Philippines.

He was a member of the elite Special Action Force (SAF) during his early years in the PNP, first from being a team leader of the 1st SF Company, later on as Company Commander until becoming Commander of the 4th Special Forces Battalion

He also distinguished himself by heading Task Force Basilan in battling Abu Sayyaf terrorists in their home turf.

Before being assigned to Pasig City, he served in various capacities in the Cordillera Administrative Region and the National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO), in particular the Eastern Police District (EPD).




